#### • Foodbank and Crowborough Community Fridge.

A few have asked about the difference between the Foodbank and Crowborough Community Fridge. The Foodbank receives donations from the public which go to produce food parcels that are delivered to needy households around Crowborough through a ticketed referral system, so as to ensure those in need get the help. Crowborough Community Fridge collects surplus food from the supermarkets and distributes this through pop-up centres where anyone can drop-in and take whatever food they need. One of those pop-up centres being St Richards on Tuesdays and Saturdays.
