
For the first time in many years we are able to offer a **face-to-face** option on **Monday 3rd March**, run by our own Peter Hall. Please do come along, book via this link:

An hour together to enrich our bible knowledge and grow in faith. *This term we are studying Hebrews!* Speak to Trish if you think you'd like to join us!



CIRT Holiday Club – (Foundation to Yr 6) 8 – 11 April – 9am – 12.30pm, at All Saints.






