Thursdays: 6pm until 7pm Saturdays: 10am until 11am Sundays: 6pm – 6.30pm




Recommended reading

SRMT - St Richards Management Team

St Richard's was founded 68 years ago, in a joint venture between All Saints and St Michael's and All Angels churches. Roughly 10 years later responsibility for the congregation and facilities being taken on by All Saints in the creation of the Parish of All Saints and St Richards.

Today that means that with All Saints being the parish church, it is the centre in terms of the Church of England governance structures PCC and Wardens. Currently three members of St Richard's are on the PCC, Lindsay, Stuart and Mark, and they represent the interests of St Richard's and Southern Crowborough and serve for a term of 3 years.

For the local governance of St Richard's there is a sub-committee of the PCC called the St Richard's Management Team – SRMT for short.
